One would never think the economy was bad if he/she watched the Barrett Jackson auto auction. Here are the selling prices on some of the top Mustangs and Shelbys.

- 1969 Shelby GT500 convertible owned only by Carroll Shelby: \$675,000

- 1969 Mustang Boss 429: 3 cars @ \$245,000, \$300,000, and \$325,000

#### **HOW BITTER WILL IT GET?**

On his 85th birthday, January 11, 2008, Carroll Shelby announced the creation of Team Shelby, which will be a virtual and real community of Shelby owners and enthusiasts. One not need to own a Shelby to join online for \$49.95 at www.teamshelby.com. As a result of this, he has ceased licensing agreements with the Shelby American Automobile Club (SAAC), which has been promoting Shelby Mustangs for 33 years. He has demanded all documents related to intellectual property, a list of all vehicles in their Shelby registry, and return of all merchandise bearing the Shelby name. SAAC says they plan to fight this battle and has set up a legal defense fund on their website, www.saac.com.

#### REPORT ON HERTZ SHELBY AUCTION

There were apparently 25 Hertz GT-H coupes and convertibles available at auction at the Cabarrus County (NC) arena on January 20, 2008. The lowest-mileage convertible had about 1,700 miles and sold for \$53,000 plus a 10% buyer's commission. The reserve on most cars was believed to be in the \$50-53K range. Many of the cars were noted to have dings, small rips in the top, missing badges, and scratches. It was unknown how many of the cars sold, but it was estimated that perhaps only 8 cars sold.

#### MUSTANG AND FORD NEWS BRIEFS

- A turbocharged V-6 Shelby Mustang may be in planning stages.
- Commercial television previews have started for the new Knight Rider series "starring" a customized Shelby GT 500 as KITT. The first episode is set to air February 19.
- Hertz is apparently in talks with Roush as the next high high-performance Mustang available as a specialty rental.
- Ford is phasing out gas caps on all its models starting with the 2009 F-150.
- Ford is offering buyouts to 54,000 hourly workers. These workers would be replaced with those earning approximately \$14 per hour as part of Ford's restructuring program.
- Ford has slipped to the #3 automaker in the US. Toyota has outpaced them in sales behind #1 GM.


