While at the Food Lion Fall Auto Fair at Lowe's Motor Speedway on September 6-7, Carolina Regional Mustang Club member Dennis Scudera's 2007 GT 500 Super Snake was chosen by Carroll Shelby to participate in a commercial for Z-Max automotive lubricant. Dennis has lived in the Carolinas for a few

years and is a former World Trade Center rescue worker who has developed health problems as a result of his work after 9/11. In addition to participating in the commercial, Mr. Shelby drove the car around the infield and signed the driver's side quarter window.

#### MUSTANG AND FORD NEWS BRIEFS

- This should not be a huge surprise to anyone, but September 2008 Mustang sales were very poor and were one of the worst months ever, even worse than the early 1970's. According to www.mustangblog.com, "Sales of Mustangs for September of 2008 were 4,910 compared to 10,266 from September of 2007 showing a 52.2% decrease in sales from the previous year. Year to date Mustang sales are 78,871 compared to 109,803 for the first nine months of 2007, which is a 28.2% drop." The model year 2008 will likely be the worst sales year in the history of the Mustang.
- If you are looking for a new Mustang GT, Ford is offering purchase incentives on the GT, which it has not done in the past when only V6 models were typically included.
- JD Power says U.S. auto sales are down 13% through September 2008 compared to 2007. Ford expects difficulties to continue well into 2009.
- Ford CEO Allan Mulally says the company has no plans to file for bankruptcy, despite its lowest stock price in 25 years of \$1.99 on October 10, 2008.
- Ford CFO Don LeClair will retire November 1. It is anticipated an executive who helped lead Ford's European turnaround will replace him.
- The new 2009 F-150 truck has started production at the Kansas City, MO plant. This truck is more fuel efficient than past models at 15 mpg city and 21 mpg highway.
- Federal loans to Ford, GM, and Chrysler in the amount of \$25 billion should help refurbish old plants and develop new electric and hybrid technology. Consumers can expect to see the results of these loans in several years.
- A plug-in hybrid version of the Ford Escape is scheduled for 2013. Although this is good news, it is a bit disconcerting given that GM and Chrysler will have plug-in hybrids available as soon as 2010.
- There is talk that Ford may offer a Shelby GT350 as a companion to the GT500.
- Barrett-Jackson auto auction will return to Las Vegas on October 15-18 at the Mandalay Bay resort and casino. Television coverage can be seen on the SPEED Channel. A 2008 Shelby GT will be auctioned for charity.


